

ISRO cranks up Gaganyaan project

Agency announces the setting up of Human Space Flight Centre, names Unnikrishnan Nair as director

- The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) said work on 'Gaganyaan', the project to send a manned mission to space by 2022, would start soon at the newly created Human Space Flight Centre (HSFC).
- The Human Space Flight Centre [based in Bengaluru] will carry out all activities related to the human programme under which the Gaganyaan Project will function.
- ISRO also announced the appointment of Unnikrishnan Nair who led ISRO's Advanced Space Transportation Programme at the Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSSC) and has already worked in the area as the director of the Human Space Flight Project — as the director of the new centre.
- The heavy lift launch vehicle GSLV Mark III, which got operational must be suitably certified or human-rated.
- It will have two non-crew flights in December 2020 and July 2021.
- The actual flight with crew is targeted to happen by December 2021 to meet the Prime Minister's goal of August 2022, India's 75th Independence anniversary.
