

Rupee strengthens to 71 with softer oil

<u>Rupee strengthens to 71 with softer oil, fund flows-Currency gains</u> <u>1.07% or 77 paise against dollar</u>

- Softer crude oil prices, along with foreign fund inflows, helped the rupee post a gain of over 1% against the dollar.
- The change raised hopes for the current account deficit to remain within the tolerance limit and for a further reduction in petrol and diesel prices.
- The rupee gained for the seventh straight session and appreciated by 1.07%, or 77 paise, against the dollar to close the day at 70.70 its highest level in 12 weeks.
